

SANTENAY LES HÂTES 2020 - 93

An atypically aromatic wine for the appellation, with a slew of red and black raspberry, plus a touch of amarena cherry dipped in bitter chocolate. Concentrated and generous, the tannins rather fine for Santenay, the bright fruit balancing them very nicely at the crisp finish. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

RULLY 1ER CRU LES CLOUX 2020 - 93

Enticing nose of peach, apricot and mirabelle. Highly-structured for this appellation, with fantastic mineral vitality that effortlessly lifts the substantial body. Long, delicately chalky finish with a lot of subtlety. Just a hint of lime there. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

MERCUREY CHAMP LADOY RED 2020 - 92

Tons of forest-berry aromas and ample body for this appellation, but also crisp, mineral acidity that gives this quite a kick at the long, vibrant finish. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

RULLY LA CRÉE 2020 - 91

Quite a shy, flinty nose that develops attractive orange-blossom character with some aeration. But this has plenty of depth and a serious tannin structure that gives it quite some weight. Long, chalky finish that is just a touch on the austere side. From 2.7 hectares. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold

RULLY 1ER CRU LA FOSSE 2020 - 91

Rich candied-citrus nose, but none of the exotic-fruit character that some wines of the vintage have. Stacks of stony minerality on the palate enable it to carry all the flesh easily. Very clean finish with excellent energy and vitality. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold.
