THIS "CLIMAT"


The name of the "Chaponnière" Climat comes from "Chapons" which means "cuttings" in Burgundy. The "Chaponnière" Climat acquired this name when it was first planted with cuttings.

TERROIR

Terroir: Clay-limestone terroir with a predominance of clay in the middle of the east-facing slope

Care: Specific pruning and debudding care to obtain even maturity between very old vines and old vines

Age: 40 years





TASTING

Appearance: Nice cherry robe with tints of purple

Bouquet: Open and pleasant nose on fresh fruits such as strawberry and raspberry. Touch of smoke and animal substances

In the mouth: The mouth is full of fruits and delicate. Nice complexity with a nice ageing potential
