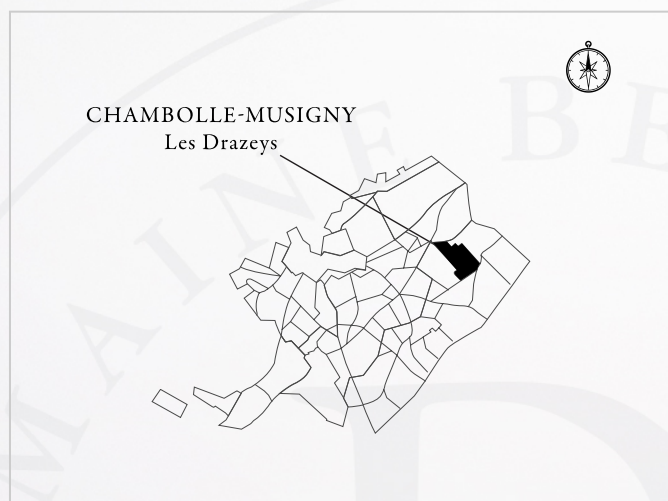
"Les Drazey's" is a word derived from Old French "Dressière", which meant a short-cut. The "Les Drazey's" Climat is at a crossroads of several lanes in Chambolle Musigny.

TERROIR

Terroirs: Clay-limestone terroir with a predominance of clay in the middle of the slope

Care: Extensive debudding to reduce yield and improve precision
