The name of the "Villerange" Climat comes from the Latin "Villar-Anicas", which means "a rural estate". Archaeologists have found the remains of a Gallo-Roman estate.

Terroir: Clay-limestone terroir with a predominance of clay in the middle of the slope Care: Pruned short to encourage vigour in these old vines Age: 50 years





TASTING

Appearance: Nice pale gold robe, brilliant

Bouquet: Open and pleasant on toasted and buttey aromas

In the mouth : with a touch of liveyness, this wine is fat and rich with a nice

toasted bread on the finish. Nice complexity
